

Installing ProSelect Frame Collections with Fixed Price by Size data

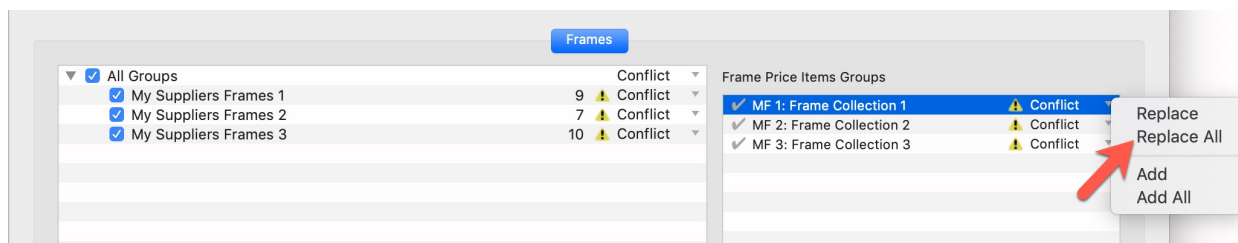
ProSelect Collection imports require at least version 2018r1 and later. Fixed Price by Size support, requires ProSelect 2022r1 and later.

- 1) Download the collection file to your local drive
- 2) In ProSelect go to Resources > Import Collection
- 3) Navigate to the downloaded file, Click Open
- 4) Choose the Frames tab
- 5) Check the frame collections wish to import, choose Import

Resolving Conflicts

If the Collection contains items that you have already installed in ProSelect then conflicts may occur.

For Frame Collections, it is recommended that you choose “Replace” for both the Frame Groups and the Prices Groups.

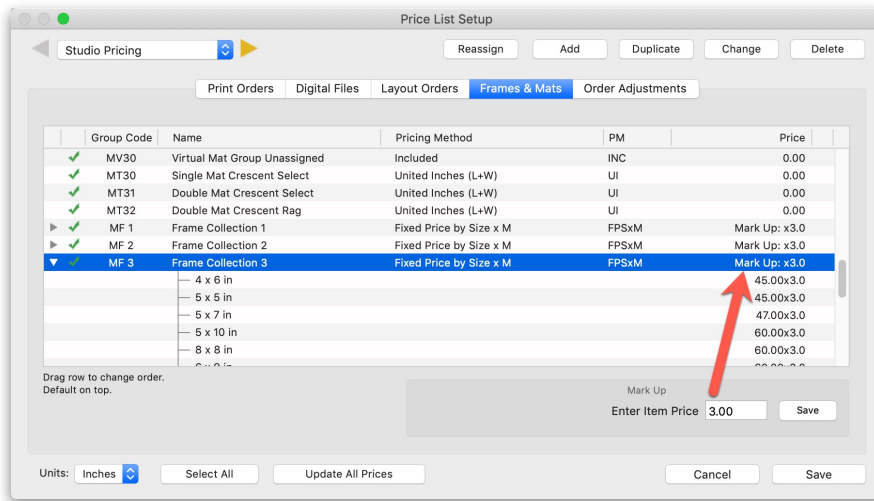


Doing so will:

- Update with the current mouldings
- Move discontinued frames to a discontinued folder
- Update to the latest pricing

About Fixed Price by Size Pricing

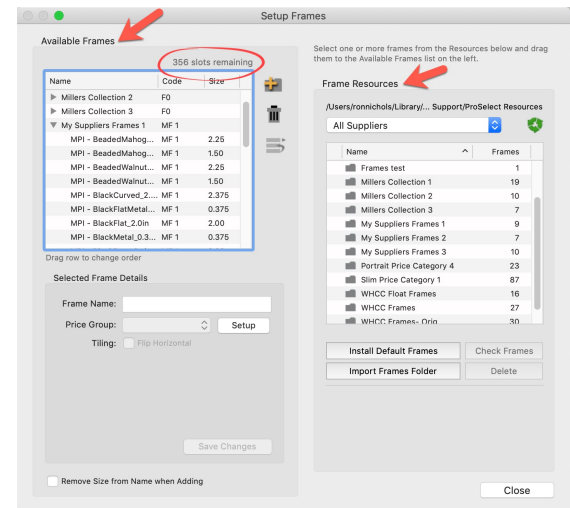
The included Fixed Price by Size pricing model includes the supplier price for each available frame size and a mark-up factor that provides a suggested selling price. Typically mark-ups are 2.5 to 3 times the photographers cost. In Orders > Price List and Products > Mats and Frames, you can change the mark-up factor to suit your individual studio needs. The mark-up can be changed for a whole price group or for individual frames.



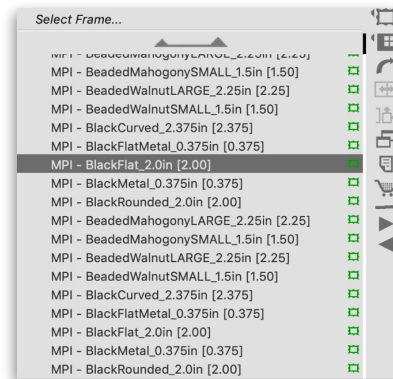
When frames are shown in Room View or Select Size View, red or green icons will appear next to the frame ID. Green indicates the frame is available in that size, red indicates it is not available. Some suppliers allow custom sizes. In that case, all sizes will show as available up to their maximum size. Pricing is then calculated using the next size that fits the selection.

Available Frames

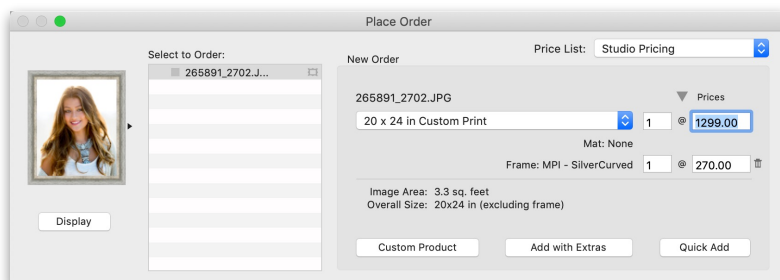
If the collection that you are loading contains more frames than you have slots available (Basic has 12 slots, Pro 500), the frames will populate in your "Available Frames" up to the maximum slots available. All the collection frames will be available in the "Frame Resources" of the Setup Frames dialog (Resources > Setup Frames). In that dialog, Available Frames can added, moved, sorted and grouped.
